As I write this month's pastoral reflection, I am readying for some time away with Allen to the log cabin we have stayed at this same time each year. I look forward to sitting by the fire with a cup of coffee in one hand and my Kindle, newly loaded with mysteries to read, in the other, as the water of the Clarion River moves silently by. It is quiet and peaceful at the campground, surrounded by tall maples, oaks and pines, chipmunks peeking up through the grass, dashing to and fro. Children have started back to school, parents and grandparents are filling their calendars, just beginning to figure out a routine for the new school year. Others are lining up their days with to-do's like cleaning up the garden and thinking about what needs done before the first snow as they look forward to football games, fall festivals and hunting season. Whatever the end of summer brings with it, I witness the hope found in moving from one season to the next, like turning pages of a book.

This morning as I headed to the church the red maple that stands alongside some mighty oaks in front of our house caught my eye as a few leaves have already fallen to the ground. This brought to mind how the trees stand as witnesses to hope, praising God. I say this because that is what trees do! If we think about it...trees

trust that a new season will follow, one after the other just as we put our trust in God as we, too, move from season to season with nary a glitch. Buds emerging in spring, giving way to leafy branches in summer, changing into their autumn colors as the "ber" (or is that "burr") months approach, laying "asleep" as the white stuff falls and melts and falls again, until spring arrives – branches always lifted upward to God like praying hands...giving God the glory for life.

I was reading an article by John Blase on scholar and writer, James Packer, who died in 2020, just five days before his 94<sup>th</sup> birthday. "Packer championed biblical authority and disciple-making and urged believers in Christ everywhere to take living for Jesus seriously." He was asked what his final words to the church would be and he replied with just four words: "Glorify Christ every way."

Blase noted that those four words reflected the life of the apostle Paul whose life is an example for us. "We can glorify (honor) God in many ways, but one is by living the life set before us and leaving the results in God's unchanging hands." Whether we are working in the yard or around the house, caring for an aging parent, juggling our calendars, bustling through our daily routines, watching our favorite sports team with some friends, or enjoying sitting by a campfire as the waters of a river pass by —the same goal holds: *Glorify Christ every way!* As we pray and read Scripture, as we lift our voices as one in worship, as we sing hymns, eat doughnuts, enjoy fellowship, study and learn, craft and play, God helps us live with devoted obedience and keeps our daily lives on track to honor Jesus in everything we say and do...from season to season.

May the new season before us be filled with the joys found within it and may you "live for Jesus", glorifying Him in every way. Thanks be to God!


